

SALES OF PREMIUM e-VOUCHERS STARTS THIS MONTH

Nearly 700 million yen project! Vouchers with 30%+ extra value!



For the purpose to ease the impact of the price increases under COVID-19 pandemic, Iruma City Office will sell premium e-vouchers, called "e-Smile Ticket," which can be used in the designated stores in the city until January 31, 2023. The electronic vouchers worth 13,500 yen as well as printed vouchers worth 13,000 yen will be sold for 10,000 yen: numbers are limited to 40,000 and 10,000 respectively. Iruma citizens can apply to purchase the vouchers through the designated website between September 5 (Mon) and 16 (Fri). For printed vouchers, you can apply by sending a postcard by September 16. If the numbers are exceeded, a lottery will be held to determine who can buy the vouchers. For more

NO PAYMENT AT HOSPITALS IN SAITAMA! CHILD MEDICAL COST SUBSIDY PROGRAM TO BE CHANGED IN OCTOBER



Iruma City provides free medical care for children (kodomo iryouhi) up to the third year of junior high school. Currently when your children receive medical care at a hospital/clinic within Iruma City, you do not have to pay from your pocket. On the other hand, when at a hospital/clinic outside Iruma, you need to pay 30% of the medical costs at hospital window and claim a reimbursement afterward to the city office with the receipts.

From October 1, 2022 and on, you don't have to do this any more as long as your children receive medical care within Saitama Prefecture. For example, at Nishi Saitama National Hospital in Tokorozawa, no payment (except some in-patient treatment costs for foods, a private room, etc.) occurs at the window. Accordingly, a new certificate of eligibility for subsidy will be sent this month.

The same change applies to the medical care subsidy for people with severe physical disabilities. But for the subsidy for single parent families, the change will be made in January 1, 2023.

FREE PCR TEST FOR PEOPLE WITHOUT SYMPTOMS

If you would like to ensure that you have not got infected with COVID-19, you can go and get tested for free without appointment, as long as you have no symptom. The temporary test site (Ogimachiya 1-632-1) is the parking space behind the Shimin Kaikan Hall near the Main Post Office. Open everyday except Monday and Tuesday, from 9:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. (lunch break 12:00 to 1:30 p.m.) Bring your ID. You will take a saliva sample by yourself at the venue, and the result will be notified later. If you are positive, call the hotline for foreign residents below to get an advice what to do. COMPULSORY HEALTH EXAM FOR NEW SCHOOL CHILDREN



Children who were born between April 2, 2016 and April 1, 2017 are due to attend elementary school next spring. By law, all new pupils must undergo a health examination which is performed at elementary schools in each area. Iruma City accepts all applicable children, regardless of their nationality, and sends the details (就学時健診通知書) by mail to their parents in the middle of this month.
